## Core C | Extended Response #1 — Edwards

Edwards' sermon entitled, "Sinners in the Hands of an Angry God" takes a harsh, yet realistic approach to evangelism. Especially in today's society, is this type of approach helpful? Harmful? Remember – your extended response should include:

- a strong, persuasive topic sentence (first sentence of response)
- 2 properly integrated proofs (i.e. one Edwards quote and one Bible verse, or two Edwards quotes)
- a clincher sentence to sum up the paragraph
- a Works Cited page

\*\*You should not write in first person (1, me). You can state your opinion without using first person. For example, rather than say "I feel that the method used by Edwards..." say "The method used by Edwards..."

\*\*No be-verbs! Choose strong verbs!
